Annie Sims, 71, of Sedalia, passed away on Saturday July 19, 2014 at Bothwell Regional Health Center. Funeral services will be held on Thursday July 24, 2014 at 10 am at Alexander-May Funeral Home in Sedalia. A visitation will be held from 5-7 pm on Wednesday July 23, 2014 at the Funeral Home.
