Shirley was loved by all those who knew her and will be greatly missed.

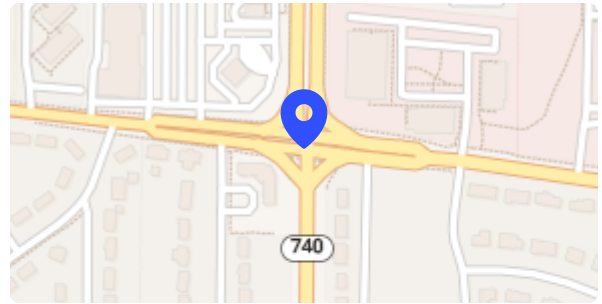
