In lieu of flowers the family would appreciate contributions to the American Diabetes Association in Mary Fayard's honor.



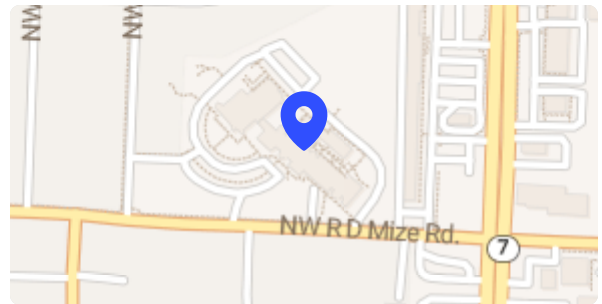

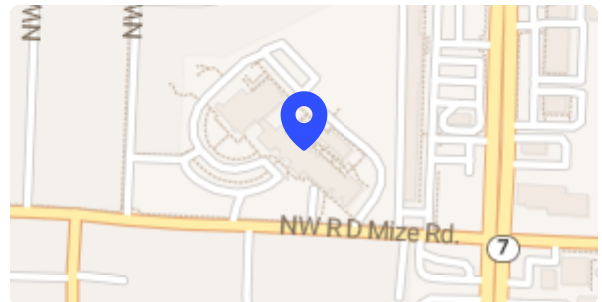

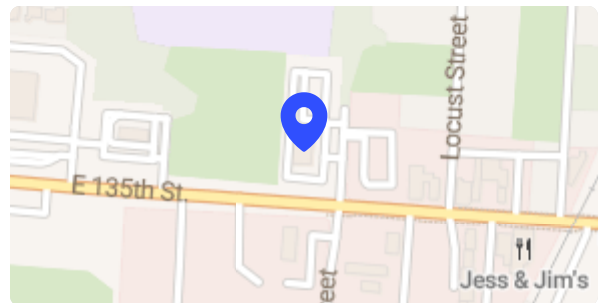
