Larney Parham, 89, of Columbia, MO, passed away on Monday, August 23, 2021 at Harry S. Truman Hospital. Funeral services will be held on Saturday, August 28, 2021 at the Friendship Missionary Baptist Church at 4:00 PM, visitation will be from 3-4PM Saturday at the church. Larney Leon Parham, 89, of Columbia, MO, was called home to be with our Lord on Monday, August 23, 2021 at the Harry S. Truman Veteran's Administration Hospital in Columbia, MO.

He attended Greensville County Training School on Low Ground Road in Emporia, VA. He was an active member of Claesville Baptist Church in Emporia, VA. He loved the Lord. 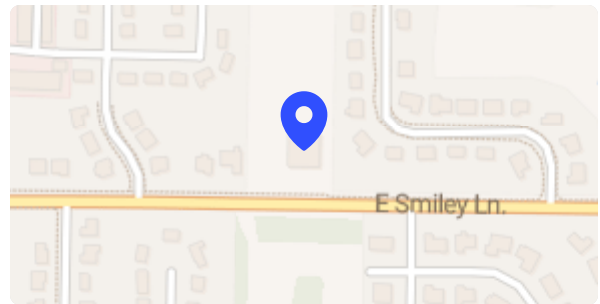

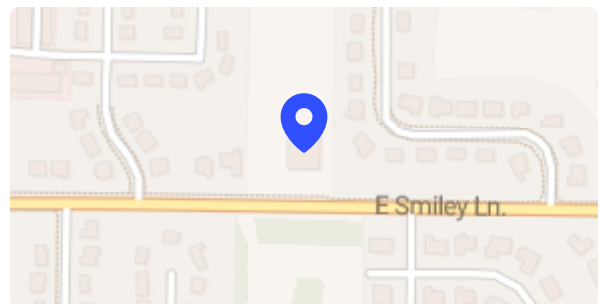

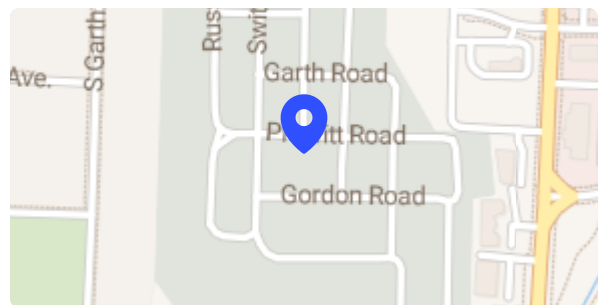
