Stephen Paul Krebs, 67 of Boonville, Missouri, passed away June 18, 2022.

Born on Mother's Day, May 8, 1955 in Los Angeles, California, Stephen was the son of the late Paul Edward Krebs and Patricia Lenore Webb Krebs. 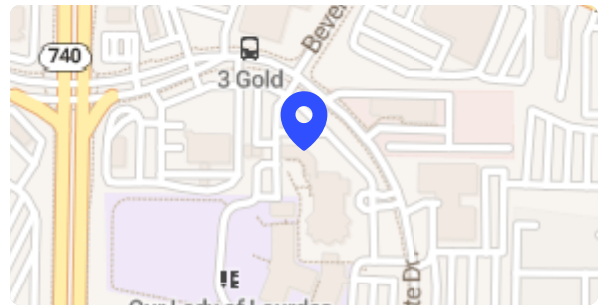

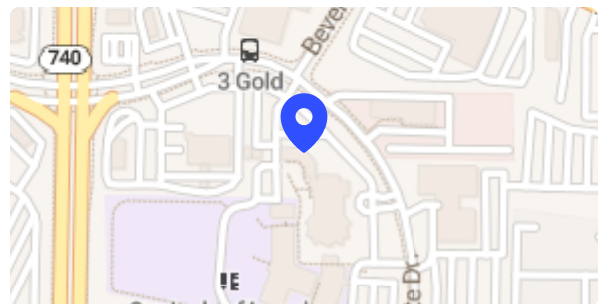
