The surviving family members will deeply miss Brian. His memory will forever remain in the hearts of those who knew and loved him.

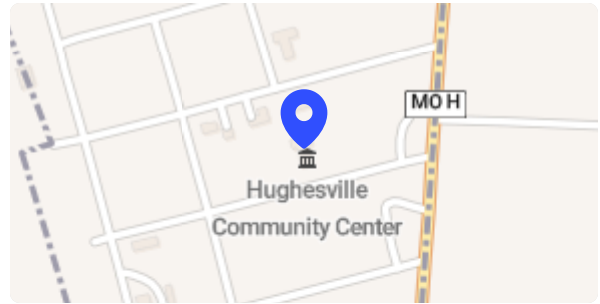
